Location Overview



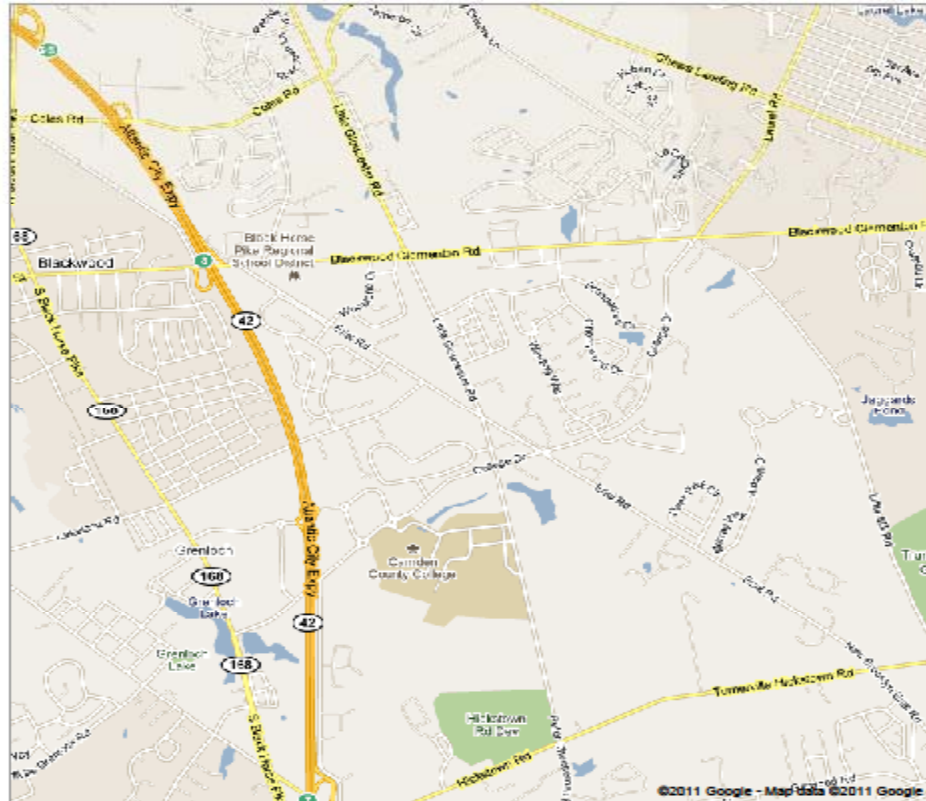

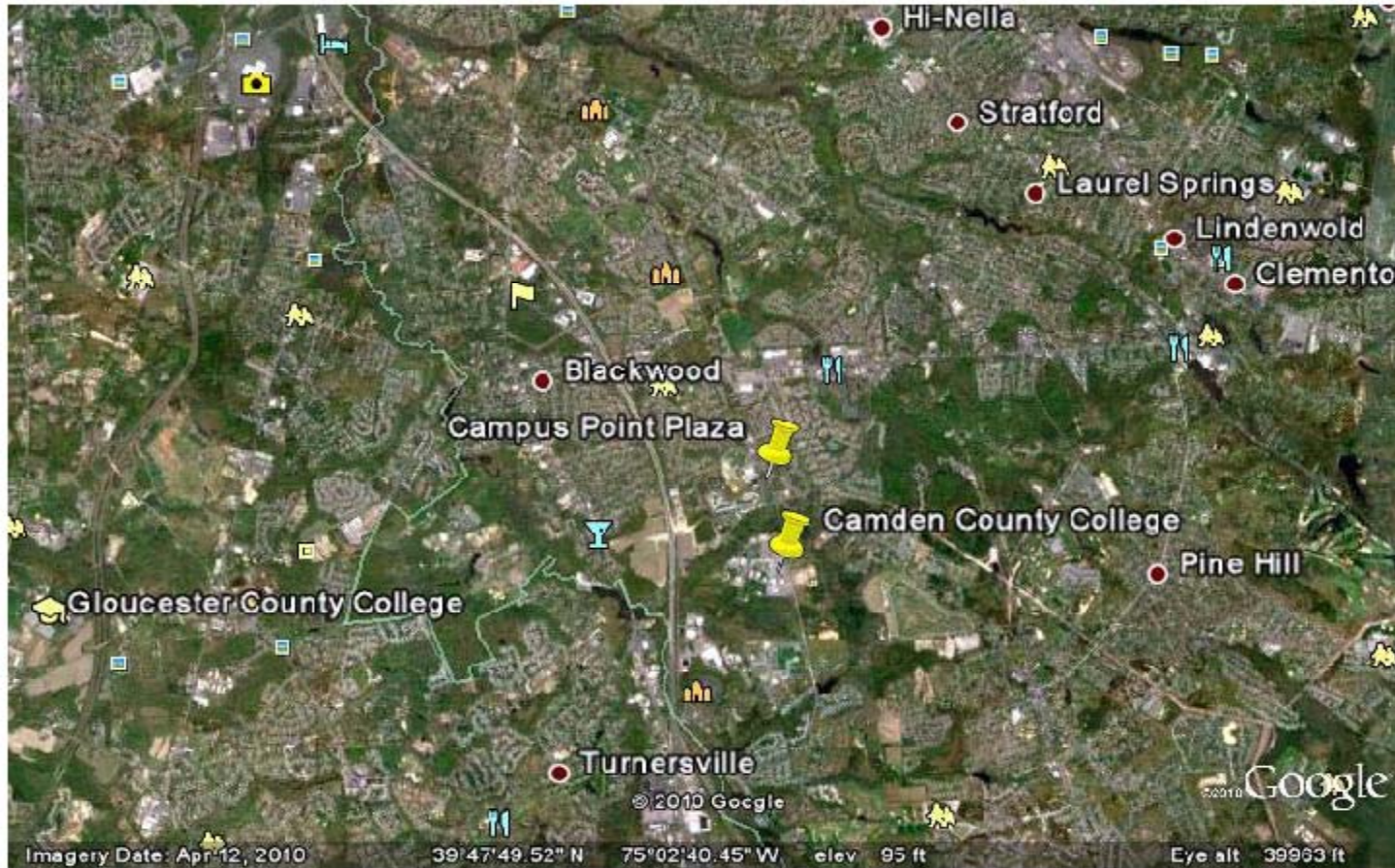
